This writ petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for issuing time bound directions to respondent No.1 to decide the petition i.e. Case No.29 of 2016 dated 31.05.2016 (Annexure P-4) titled as “Mardana and others Vs. The Joint Secretary, Revenue & Disaster Management Department, Haryana and others”, which is stated to be pending for 19.04.2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners had filed the above-said case (Annexure P-4) against the order dated 10.03.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2 under the Haryana Evacuee Properties (Management & Disposal) Act, 2008, as amended in the year 2010, in which, the service is complete and even the

written arguments have been submitted, but the said case has not been decided as yet and has thus, prayed that respondent No.1 be directed to decide the said case expeditiously.

Learned State counsel for appearing on behalf of the respondents has submitted that every endeavour would be made by respondent No.1 to decide the said case expeditiously.

Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide Case No.29 of 2016 dated 31.05.2016 (Annexure P-4) titled as “Mardana and others Vs. The Joint Secretary, Revenue & Disaster Management Department, Haryana and others”, expeditiously.
