This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the alleged demarcation report dated 18.07.2022 (Annexure P-21), with an alternative prayer for directing learned trial Court to decide the objections filed by the petitioner vide reply dated 12.08.2011 (Annexure P-23).
