This is a petition seeking regular bail in FIR No.226, dated 03.07.2022 under Sections 387, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sector-6, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the main accused namely Rajesh Kumar has already been granted the concession of interim bail vide order dated 08.08.2022 (Annexure P-5) passed in CRM-M-35015-2022, whereas the other two co-accused have been granted the concession of regular bail vide orders dated 20.12.2022 (Annexure P-3) and 11.10.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed in CRM-M-56816-2022 and CRM-M-45203-2022, respectively.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Gagandeep Singh Chhina, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, who has filed the custody certificate of the petitioner, which is taken on record. According to the

custody certificate, the petitioner is behind the bars for the last 3 months and 14 days so far. He does not dispute the above said fact with regard to bail granted to the other co-accused persons.

In the light of the above-said facts and circumstances, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The present petition is, hereby, allowed.
