The present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, praying for taking appropriate action against the respondents for having violated orders dated 26.04.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in RFA No. 680-681-2018.

Perusal of the documents, relied upon by counsel for respondent No. 1, shows that the amount has already been paid to the petitioners pursuant to the order dated 26.04.2018 (Annexure P-1) and, as such, no case for contempt or violation of the aforesaid order is made out.

Since counsel for the petitioners has raised some dispute qua calculations, required to be followed in the matter, the same can be raised in the execution proceedings.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to approach the executing Court to get their grievance redressed.
