1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.207 dated 21.11.2015, registered for offences under Sections 304, 279 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise deed dated 16.01.2020, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.
2. State counsel has placed on record a copy of judgment dated 20.07.2023 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana and has submitted that the petitioner has been acquitted of the charge framed against him by extending him the benefit of doubt.
3. In view of the above development, petition has become infructuous and is dismissed as such.
