ANOOP CHITKARA, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the petition seeking fair investigation and transfer of same to Vigilance Branch has rendered infurctuous because the challan has already been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that Police be directed to supply complete paper book of the challan to the petitioner through present counsel within one week from today. After that in case the petitioner feels that he is still aggrieved, he be given liberty to make a representation to the concerned Superintendent of Police with a time bound direction decide the same.

In the given facts, the present petition is disposed of with following directions:-

- (i) Hand over a complete paperbook of the challan to the petitioner through his present counsel within one week from today.
- (ii) In case of any grievances, it shall be permissible for the petitioner to file a representation to the concerned Commissioner within one month from the receipt of such challan. In case such representation is filed, the concerned Commissioner shall decide the same himself or by authorising any Officer of IPS cadre within two months by passing speaking and reasoned order.

Liberty is reserved to the petitioner to come to this Court again.
