1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.38 dated 11.04.2019 under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur.

2. Vide order dated 09.12.2020, while noticing the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, whereby he had restricted his prayer to grant of interim bail to the petitioner on account of his medical condition as he was stated to be suffering from cancer, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner.

3. In compliance of the order dated 24.08.2023, learned State counsel has filed affidavit of Amandeep Kaur, SI, Incharge Police Post,

Badrukhan, Police Station Longowal, today in the Court, which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions and a copy thereof supplied to learned counsel opposite.

4. In view of the averments made in the affidavit filed today, no ground is made out for extension of the interim bail, which was granted to the petitioner vide order dated 09.12.2020. The petition, as such, stands dismissed and the petitioner is directed to surrender back before the trial Court on the next date fixed before it, i.e. 17.10.2023.

5. All the pending CM applications also stands disposed of accordingly.
