This petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondent-Commission to award nine marks to the petitioner for teaching experience of four years and six months on the post of Post Graduate Teacher (Math).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that during pendency of the petition, the petitioner was awarded nine marks for experience, and pursuant thereto he was selected for the post also. However, appointment is still awaited. It is further submitted that remaining claims of the petitioner regarding consequential benefits, including seniority and fixation of pay at par with the candidates lower in merit, remain; and he may be permitted to file appropriate representation before respondent No.2 in that regard.

3. Learned State counsel submits that in case such representation is filed, the same will be decided expeditiously.

4. In view thereof, the instant petition is disposed of granting

liberty to the petitioner to move appropriate representation before respondent No.2 within a week from today. In case any such representation is moved, the same shall be considered and decided by respondent No.2 by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within six weeks from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
