Present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking quashing of order dated 24.11.2022 (Annexure P-5) passed by the learned trial Court at Moga vide which the bail order of the petitioner has been cancelled and now the petitioner is summoned through non-bailable warrants of arrest in case having FIR No.202 dated 25.9.2021 registered under Sections 379, 411 IPC and Section 21(3) of Mines and Minerals (Regulation of Development) Act at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

Notice of motion.

Mr. C.L.Pawar, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and on instructions from ASI Gurdev Singh submits that during the investigation, petitioner-Pardeep Kumar was found innocent and thereafter, cancellation report was filed and the same was accepted by the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate vide order dated 17.3.2022.

State counsel further submits that as the cancellation report qua

the present petitioner is accepted by the Court concerned, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of above, the present petition is hereby disposed of and the impugned order is set aside with direction to the learned trial Court to pass fresh order in light of assertions which are made today by the State counsel.
