The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0249 dated 29.12.2022 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 409 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Bichhore, District Nuh, Haryana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 03.03.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 03.03.2023 but a sum of Rs.25,000/- received by him is yet to be recovered from him.

Be that as it may, the present proceedings cannot be used to recover the cash amount purportedly received by the petitioner. In this view of the matter, interim order dated 03.03.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
