1. The petitioner is a wife of respondent. In this revision petition, the challenge is to the correctness of assessment made by the Family Court while awarding the maintenance *pendente lite* to the wife and two minor school going children. The prayer is to modify and enhance the same.

2. On the other hand, on the direction of the Court, salary slips has been filed by the respondent, in which though the total salary of the respondent is Rs.37,483/-, however, his net payable salary is Rs.20,662/-.

3. The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the respondent owns 1 kanal built up house in Nangal and he has agricultural land in his father's name. He further submits that the respondent has substantial earnings from various sources.

4. This aforesaid contention of the learned counsel representing the petitioner is contested by the learned counsel representing the respondent.

5. This Court is called upon to exercise revisional jurisdiction. In the opinion of the Court, the amount of maintenance *pendente lite* is only an

interim assessment made by the Court on the basis of material produced. Such order is amenable to change as and when fresh application with additional material is produced.

6. In view of the aforesaid facts, the revision petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an application before the Family Court, where the proceedings are pending.

7. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
