The present petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to take appropriate decision on the report dated 02.07.2019 submitted by the Lokayukta, Haryana.

Reply on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 had been filed through Executive Engineer (Mech.), PWD (B&R) Ambala wherein it was submitted that on the basis of the report of the Lokayukta dated 02.07.2019, an explanation of respondent No.3 was called for vide communication dated 24.10.2019. A reply was accordingly filed on 31.10.2019, whereupon the said reply was accepted. The competent Authority being satisfied with the said reply submitted the issues to the Government vide letter No.95-IC-M-13/211492/I&CI dated 25.11.2019 for appropriate decision.

A separate reply had also been filed on behalf of respondent No.3, wherein he has stated that the Government had taken a decision and communicated the same vide memo No.8/54/2013-1-B&R (E) dated 25.11.2021. A warning had been issued to the private respondent to be more careful in future. He contends that the report/recommendations of the Lokayukta have been considered by the Government and an appropriate decision has been taken thereupon. Hence, no grievance survives in the present petition.

The said reply had been filed on behalf of the respondents in the month of February, 2022 and no replication/rejoinder controverting/rebutting the stand has been filed.

In view of the aforesaid uncontroverted stand, the present petition is disposed as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is however, granted to the petitioner to seek redressal of his grievance, if any, in a manner known to law.

Any other misc. application(s) also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
