This is a petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India praying for setting aside the order dated 01.08.2011 passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kapurthala, vide which the application for *ad valorem* Court fee filed by the petitioners/defendants has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that during the pendency of the present petition, the main suit from which the present petition has arisen; itself has been decided vide judgment and decree dated **31.03.2014** passed in **Civil Suit No.58 of 14.06.2007** titled as '**Bahadur Singh and another Vs.
