RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of directions to respondent No.4 not to harass him time and again without any rhyme and reason by calling him to the Vigilance Bureau Office, Jalandhar and that too without issuing him a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

It has been submitted by counsel for the petitioner that though there is FIR No.216 dated 09.12.2022, under Sections 353, 186, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.6, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar against the petitioner, however, he has already joined investigation and he has been granted regular bail as well. He is facing wrath of the investigating agencies and is being unnecessarily called to the police station time and again. He submits that the petitioner is made to sit in the police station for hours together just in order to humiliate him. He submits that the petitioner is ready to cooperate with the investigation, if at all is required. He further submits that his only grievance is that the investigating agencies should call him

by adhering to the procedure laid down under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate representation before respondent No.3 within a week and if the same is filed then respondent No.3 would decide the same in accordance with law within 15 days thereafter.
