The petitioners are seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to protect their life and liberty at the hands of the private respondents who have not accepted their marriage which was solemnized on 13.01.2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that ever since the marriage of the petitioners, who are admittedly adults, on 13.01.2023, the private respondents who are family members of petitioner No.1 have been threatening them with dire consequences. He submits that a representation (Annexed P-4) dated 23.01.2023 was given to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, however, no action had been taken against the private respondents.

Notice of motion only to official respondents.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ankur Bali, Addl. P.P., U.T., Chandigarh, who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for U.T., Chandigarh on instructions has apprised this Court that the statement of the private

respondent No.4, who is mother of petitioner No.1, was recorded wherein she stated that they had never threatened the petitioners and in fact they had accepted the marriage of her son with petitioner No.2.

In the circumstances, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that he would not press the instant petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
