The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.40 dated 06.02.2022 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 427, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Bhargo Camp, Jalandhar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 22.02.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 24.05.2023 by way of an affidavit of Gagandeep Singh Ghuman, Assistant Commissioner of Police (West), Commissionerate, Jalandhar has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Raghuvir Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 22.02.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

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joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
