This petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to add Sections 452, 506, 34 of IPC in FIR No.61 dated 12.04.2021 registered under Section 448 IPC at Police Station Sector 34, Chandigarh, by conducting the investigation in a fair and independent manner and to decide the representation dated 19.04.2021 and dated 19.01.2022 (Annexure P-5 and P-9) filed by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh submits that investigation in this case has been completed and challan stands presented before the trial Court against the four accused persons.

Petitioner, who appears in person, submits that the FIR was registered against the five persons but the challan stands presented only against four persons and one person has been exonerated by the police authorities.

In the light of the fact that investigation in this case has been completed and challan stands presented before the trial Court, no direction as

prayed for can be issued to the respondents at this stage. If the petitioner is

aggrieved from the investigation conducted by the police authorities, she may take appropriate remedy in accordance with law.

The present petition stands disposed of in aforesaid terms.
