This is an application for grant of exemption from filing
certified copies of Annexure P-1 to Annexure P-2.

Allowed as prayed for.

CRM-M-4993-2023:

The two petitioners Savita and Amrita are in custody since
27.03.2022 and have prayed for grant of regular bail under Section 439
Cr.P.C in case FIR No.104 dated 27.03.2022 registered under Section 20 of
Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1984 (Section 27-A, 29 of
NDPS Act added later on) registered at Police Station City Badli, District
Jhajjar.

As per the prosecution allegations, 42.500 Kg. ganja was
recovered from a car bearing registration No.HR-AG-5078; and 63 Kg.
ganja was recovered from three bags kept under mat and stepney of Scorpio
car bearing registration No.HR-13G-8188.

It is alleged that petitioners and two others were occupants of
the Scorpio car. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioners is that

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they are neither owner of the car nor related with the owner in any manner. In fact, petitioner No.2 is suffering from stone problem and was on the way to hospital along with her mother i.e. petitioner No.1. They had requested the driver of the Scorpio to drop them to the hospital.

As per the custody certificate of petitioner No.1 Savita placed on record by learned State counsel, petitioner has no criminal antecedents. It is also informed that investigation is completed; challan has already been filed, and no witness has been examined so far.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, petitioners are admitted to bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
