This petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction for transfer of investigation in complaint lodged by the petitioner at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana, to any other police station in District Ludhiana, since respondent No.4, investigating officer, has colluded with the nominated accused persons and is helping them by pressurising the petitioners to compromise the matter.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to consider and decide the representation dated 05.11.2022 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioners.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of

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respondents No.1 to 3-State.

Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, that shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioners.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
