This is the second petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.631 dated 16.10.2020 under Section 304-B IPC, registered at Police Station, Samalkha, District Panipat. (charges framed under sections 304-B, 406, 498-A and in alternative section 302 IPC).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is behind bars since 23.10.2020.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Ramesh submits that only one prosecution witness remains to be examined and the next date before the Trial Court is 27.1.2023.
