By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has sought the relief of anticipatory/pre-arrest bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.131 dated 09.12.2022 registered at Police Station Sekhwan, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, under Section 306 read with Section 34 IPC.

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Bikram Singh from the above-referred Police Station, informs the Court that in compliance of the order as passed by the Co-ordinate Bench on 14.02.2023, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and her custodial

interrogation is not required and moreover, she is also not involved in any other criminal case.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 14.02.2023, is hereby made absolute.

4. However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
