SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (ORAL)

It is submitted that respondent No.6 has filed a complaint against one Gurpreet Singh (nephew of the petitioner) of having defrauded him by taking money for sending his sister abroad, but not doing so.

The matter was compromised and Gurpreet Singh agreed to return a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- received by him. Subsequently, he returned only 1.5 lacs. Presently, he has gone abroad and the petitioner being his only relative in India is being harassed by the police. Thus, directions be issued to respondents No.2 to 5 not to harass the petitioner and his family members.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only.

Mr. Pankaj Khullar, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, no reply is necessary.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to treat this petition as a representation and to take appropriate action,

thereupon as found fit by passing a speaking order within 8 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Meanwhile, it be ensured that the petitioner and his family members are not harassed by the police.
