The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of interim bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.253 dated 27.07.2021 registered under Sections 302, 324, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Badli, District Jhajjar for a period of 03 weeks to look after her ill mother.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the mother of the petitioner is suffering from incisional hernia and acute kidney injury for which the doctor had suggested an immediate surgery. There is no male member in the family to look after her. Therefore, the petitioner may be granted interim bail for a period of 03 weeks.

On the other hand, learned State counsel and learned

counsel for the complainant have vehemently opposed the present petition on the ground that the mother of the petitioner has already been discharged from the hospital.

In view of above, no ground for grant of interim bail to the petitioner at his stage is made out in the present petition.
