This is an application for placing on record the copy of bank
statement (Annexure P-5) and ID Card (Annexure P-6).

CRM-M-4554-2023:

The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition
under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.113 dated 02.06.2022 registered
under Sections 22(c), 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station
Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

As per the prosecution allegations 2500 intoxicant tablets of
Tramadol were recovered from conscious possession of co-accused Rohit
Sharma @ Raju. During interrogation said co-accused nominated the name
of the petitioner who had allegedly supplying the contraband to him. After
his arrest on 17.06.2022, disclosure statement of the petitioner was recorded.

Raid was conducted at his house but nothing was recovered from him.

As per the custody certificate placed on record, petitioner is in custody for the last 10 months and 2 days with no criminal antecedents.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
