This is second first petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR no.137 dated 25.08.2019 registered under Sections 302, 307, 323, 34 IPC and Sections 25/27/30 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Section 27 of the Arms Act deleted and Section 30 of the Arms Act added later on) at Police Station Sadar Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition, at this stage. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the petitioner has been in custody from 27.09.2019 and out of 31 witnesses, only 7 witnesses have been examined, thus, the trial is likely to take time and prays that the trial Court be directed to expedite the trial.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage. The trial Court is requested to expedite the trial.
