GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer to the extent that he may not be unnecessarily harassed in respect of the complaint dated 22.11.2022 (Annexure P-6) submitted by respondent No.8 as he has already associated himself with the inquiry.

In view of the limited prayer made on behalf of the petitioner, it is directed that respondent No.6 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur shall ensure that the petitioner is not unnecessarily called to the Police Station repeatedly, as the petitioner is a professional and is already stated to have joined inquiry and has rather taken a plea that he was not present at the place where the alleged offence is stated to have been committed.

With the aforesaid direction, the instant petition stands disposed of.

It is, however, clarified that the aforesaid order is not to be construed as any expression as regards petitioner’s plea of *alibi*.
