VIKAS BAHL, J (ORAL)

This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No.7 to decide the statutory appeal of the petitioners under the Public Premises Act in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that against the order of eviction dated 03.01.2023, the petitioners have filed the appeal before respondent No.7 along with the stay application. He submitted that the said appeal is now listed for 01.02.2023 and stated that the petitioners would be satisfied in case respondent No.7 is directed to consider the appeal along with the stay application for preliminary hearing on the said date.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Ms. Surbhi Malik, Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana, has submitted that respondent No.7 would take up the appeal along with the stay application for preliminary hearing on 01.02.2023 and would pass the appropriate orders.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.7 to consider the appeal along with the stay application for preliminary hearing on 01.02.2023 and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.
