1. The correctness of the concurrent findings of fact arrived at by the Courts below is assailed by the plaintiff in this second appeal. He claims entitlement to the benefit of Assured Career Progression Scheme on expiry of 24 years.
2. Both the Courts have found that the appellant has already been granted two benefits under Assured Career Progression Scheme, however, he is not entitled to the next benefit, which is due on expiry of 24 years of service because he was promoted as head teacher on 30.12.1993 before the expiry of 24 years.
3. The learned counsel representing the appellant though made sincere attempts, however, failed to draw the attention of the Court to any error.
4. Hence, dismissed.
5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
