HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed raising a grievance that the mother of the petitioner unfortunately died while in service on 17.08.2009 but the benefit in respect of the service rendered by her have not been extended to the petitioner, who is the only legal heir of her.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even the benefits under the Haryana Civil Services (Compassionate Financial Assistance or Appointment) Rules, 2006, which were applicable at the time of the death of the mother of the petitioner, have also not been released, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the redressal of the grievance as raised in the present petition, the petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 04.11.2022 (Annexure P-7) which is still

pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the legal notice dated 04.11.2022 (Annexure P-7) is still pending consideration with the authority concerned, the same will be decided within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, after the decision of the legal notice, any benefit is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will also be released to him within a further period of four weeks.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

8. Ordered accordingly.
