The Prayer in this petition under Section 439 Cr.PC is for the grant of regular bail in case FIR No.300 dated 20.11.2022 under Sections 379-B and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Model Town, Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

As per the FIR the allegations are that two persons snatched away the purse of the complainant containing Mobile Phone brand A/20 Samsung, ATM Card of Feather Bank, Voter Card, Aadhaar Card, PAN Card, Rs.950/- of Indian Currency.

The counsel for the petitioner contends that a compromise has been effected between the parties as was borne out from document dated 5.12.2022 (Annexure P-2). The petitioner was in custody since 20.11.2022. Therefore, he may be granted the concession of bail.

The learned Counsel for the State on the other hand contends seriousness of the allegation do not entitle the petitioner to the grant of bail. He however, does not dispute the fact that a compromise has bene arrived at between the parties.

The Counsel for the complainant also admits the factum of compromise having been arrived at between the parties and he has no objection if the petitioner is granted the concession of bail.

I have heard learned Counsel for the parties at length.

Admittedly as per document Annexure P-2 a compromise has been arrived at between the parties. The petitioner is in custody since 20.11.2022 and as such his further incarceration is not required.

Thus, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and petitioner-**Vishal** son of Sh. Balwant Singh is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The Petition stands disposed of.
