Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the issue involved in the present petition has already been decided by this Court in CWP No.19244 of 2019 titled as **Arvind and others Vs. State of Haryana and another** decided on 05.09.2023, and the petitioners intend to approach the respondents for the grant of appropriate relief keeping in view the settled principle of law in **Arvind and others (supra)** hence the representation which the petitioners intend to file, may be decided by the respondents in a time bound manner so that the petitioners do not suffer any prejudice.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any claim is raised by the petitioners by way of any representation, the same will be considered in accordance with law keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation and the judgment of this Court in **Arvind and others (supra)** will be kept in mind while passing the order concerned.

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Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the State, the present petition may be disposed of as not pressed with liberty to file the representation with the respondents.
