The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.134 dated 19.02.2020 under Sections 406, 420, 506 (whereas Section 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC added later on) 148, 149, 323, 324, 452, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt., District Ambala (Haryana).

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 20.04.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 20.04.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 20.04.2022 is

made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

In addition a sum of Rs.2 lacs shall be deposited by the petitioner before the Trial Court without prejudice to his rights.

Petition stands disposed of.
