The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for seeking permission to go abroad after release of the passport of the petitioner. Liberty is sought by the petitioner to appear before Trial Court through his counsel in case FIR No.364 dated 19.12.2012 under Section 36 of PUDA Act registered at P.S. Sadar, Jalandhar.

At the very outset the counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition. However, a prayer is made that directions be issued to the Trial Court to conclude the Trial expeditiously since the co-accused of the petitioner already stands acquitted.

In view of the above prayer, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed. However, the Trial Court is directed to conclude the Trial within a period of 06 months from the next date fixed before it.
