Mr. Pankaj Middha, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of respondents and has no objection for the grant of the prayer as raised in the present application.

Keeping in view the averments made in the application, which are duly supported by an affidavit, the application is allowed and hearing the main petition i.e CWP No.2861 of 2021 is preponed from 07.11.2023 to today.

**CWP No.2861 of 2021**

In the present petition, the petitioner, who are contractual employees have impugned the order by which they have been relieved from

service and the only prayer which has been raised during the course of hearing is that there are posts, which are lying vacant and keeping in view the instructions issued by the Government of Haryana (Annexure P-10) dated 02.02.2019, the petitioners are entitled for adjustment on the said vacant post in case the work exists, hence the respondents are under obligation to adjust the petitioners against the vacant post, where the work still exists even as of now.

Learned State counsel submits that in case the petitioners are of the view that the similar post, on which the petitioners were working are still lying vacant and according to the department work for those posts exists and those posts need to be manned, the petitioners can file appropriate representation before the concerned authorities and the same will be considered by the department concerned and appropriate order will be passed within a period of six weeks on receipt of a copy of any such representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may be disposed of as having been not pressed with liberty to file appropriate representation.

Ordered accordingly.
