The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC for directing respondent No.2 to direct respondent No.3 to conduct a fair and proper investigation in FIR No.286 dated 20.09.2022 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala and all the subsequent proceedings arises in the aforesaid FIR against the petitioner expeditiously and also for directing respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 16.01.2023 (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State of Punjab.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Patiala to consider and decide the representation dated 16.01.2023 (Annexure P-3) alleged to has been submitted by the petitioner for conducting the fair and impartial inquiry in the said FIR.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim

of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within 6 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
