The present revision petition pertains to the year 2018. On 25.08.2022 the following order was passed :

“On 30.07.2019 none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Yet again on 14.11.2019 none had put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Today also no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. However, keeping in view the fact that the matter has been taken up for the first time after 2019 due to the intervening circumstances created because of Covid-19 Pandemic, one last opportunity is granted to argue the matter failing which the present revision petition shall be liable to be dismissed for non-prosecution.
