Prayer in the present petition is for setting aside the order dated 10.01.2020 passed by the learned Judge Special Court, Ludhiana in a case FIR No.235, dated 05.07.2018, registered under Sections 22, 61 and 85 NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Sadar, Jagraon, whereby, while acquitting the accused Baljit Singh alias Bittu, the petitioner alongwith four other police officials, has been straightway held guilty and convicted for the offence under Section 58(1) (a) & (c) of the NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* the present petition is covered by the ratio of the law laid down by this Court in CRM-M-2725-2020 titled as Ramji Dass and another vs. State of Punjab, decided on 06.02.2023 and may be disposed of in the same terms.
