The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.191 dated 18.09.2021 registered under Sections 420 and 406 IPC, 1860 at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 28.03.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Gurmail Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 28.03.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
