The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 14.07.2021 and subsequent order dated 08.11.2021.

As per affidavit of Chief Director, Vigilance Bureau, Punjab dated 21.11.2022, permission under Section 17-A of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 has been granted by the Govt. of Punjab to probe the matter. Thereafter, Vigilance Enquiry No.08 dated 28.09.2022 is registered against five persons including three IAS officers and two ex-ministers.

During the course of arguments, learned senior counsel requested the Court to supply the sanction order.

Learned State counsel has placed on record relevant documents, after supplying copy of the same to learned senior counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further action is called for in the present petition and the same is rendered as infructuous.
