By way of this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.532 dated 27.12.2022 registered under Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

As per the allegations, borne out from the order dated 12.01.2023 (Annexure P.1), petitioner was arrested on 29.12.2022 and recovery of country made pistol of .32 bore along with 2 live cartridges were effected from him. Petitioner is in custody for the last one month and three days as per the custody certificate placed on record.

Petitioner is involved in one more case bearing FIR No.73 dated 29.04.2022 registered at Police Station Kotwali, Patiala under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC but he is on anticipatory bail in that case as submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner. Case is triable by learned Magistrate. Further investigation/trial may take time to conclude.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed.

Petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing personal bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Area Magistrate concerned.
