The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.46 dated 8.7.2022 under Sections 376 (2)(n), 328, 506 and 34 IPC read with Sections 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1881, registered at Police Station Women, Sector 51, District Gurugram (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Short reply filed by the learned State counsel dated 27.5.2023 is taken on record. It is to the effect that during investigation allegations levelled against the petitioners could not be substantiated and challan in the case is to be filed only against the co-accused/son of the petitioners.
