The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C., has been invoked for quashing of FIR No. 559, dated 09.12.2020, under Section 346 IPC, registered at Police Station Jind City, District Jind.

In the present case notice of motion was issued on 10.02.2021 on the assertions raised by learned counsel for the petitioner that as per the allegations contained in the FIR on the face of it, suggests that it was false and frivolous FIR and was the result of the statement/complaint made by Sanjeev Kumar on the allegations that his wife, daughter and son have been taken away by the petitioner, who is brother-in-law (Saddu) and a direction was issued not to take any coercive steps against the petitioner.

In pursuance of the notice of motion, reply dated 16.04.2021 was filed.

Today, during the course of hearing, learned State counsel submits that closure report dated 09.07.2021 has been prepared and will be submitted to the Court within a period of one month from today.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
