Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing impugned sanction order dated 10.08.2022, Annexure P-1, with all subsequent proceedings, vide which, sanction has been granted under Section 197, Cr.P.C., and Section 19 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (for short “PC Act”) for prosecution of the petitioner in FIR No.22 dated 11.01.2022, registered for offences under Section 386, IPC, and Sections 7 and 13 of PC Act, at Police Station City Narnaul, District Mahendergarh, Annexure P-2.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to avail the remedy available to him in accordance with law.
