1. Vide this common order above-mentioned two civil revision shall be disposed of as similar question of law and facts are involved therein.

3. This petition has been filed seeking setting aside of order dated 10.8.2018 whereby the application for release of 75% amount under Section 19 of the Micro Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006 was ordered to be clubbed with the main case.
