SANJAY VASHISTH, J. (Oral)

While confronted with the order dated 10.01.2023 passed in CRWP No. 201 of 2023 (Annexure P-6), learned counsel for the petitioner admits that said petition also contained similar prayer as in the present writ petition.

Order dated 10.01.2023 passed in CRWP-201-2023 says as under:

“After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of present petition with liberty to seek alternative remedy available to the petitioner under the law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as aforementioned.”

Since already counsel for the petitioner had withdrawn the said petition to avail some alternative remedy available to the petitioner, under the law, present petition is not maintainable.

Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed being not maintainable.
