The present application has been filed for recalling the order dated 17.03.2023 by which Civil Revision No.7948-2018 has been dismissed for non-prosecution.

Keeping in view the averments made in the application which are duly supported by an affidavit, application is allowed. The Civil Revision No.7948-2018 is restored to its original number.

Application stands disposed of.

Main case

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that when the impugned order dated 04.10.2018 (Annexure P-1) was passed the petitioner was residing in Newzealand, due to which factor the

application filed under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, was dismissed but now the petitioner has returned back to India and is not employed and therefore the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed with liberty to petitioner to file appropriate application afresh in the changed circumstances seeking relief under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
