SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside impugned order dated 08.12.2022, Annexure P-4, whereby, petitioner has been ordered to be transferred from Jind to Kaithal, ignoring his disability. Direction has also been sought to the respondents to consider the representation dated 13.12.2022, Annexure P-6, submitted by the petitioner.

By making a reference to Disability Certificate dated 04.03.2009, Annexure P-1, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is 50% physically disabled. Counsel submits that the petitioner was appointed as Junior Engineer and posted at Jind against a vacant post by giving relaxation in the Government policy. He submits that by impugned order,

Annexure P-4, petitioner has been transferred to Kaithal, though, order has been kept in abeyance keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is a person with disability. He submits that the petitioner gave a representation dated 13.12.2022, Annexure P-6, highlighting his plight with the request that a sympathetic view may be taken. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representation, Annexure P-6.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Anant Kataria, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Given the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it necessary to call for a response from the respondents.

Having heard counsel for the parties, but without commenting upon the pleas taken by the petitioner, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine the representation, Annexure P-6, within a fortnight from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

A copy of the writ petition and representation, Annexure P-6, be communicated to respondent No.2.
