1. The petitioner, through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is seeking directions to respondents to re-issue his passport with correct date of birth.

Mr. Amit Sharma, learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Regional Passport Officer, submits that matter is under active consideration and competent authority has sought report from Punjab School Education Board to determine actual date of birth of the petitioner. He further submits that as soon as report is received from the Board, the application of the petitioner would be processed and appropriate order would be passed within 6 weeks.

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3. Mr. Harshit Jain, learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the aforesaid arrangement.
4. In view of statement of both sides, the petition stands disposed of.
