Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has not joined the investigation in pursuance to the order dated 01.02.2023 in the instant FIR No.85 dated 02.10.2022, under Sections 452/324/323/148/149 of IPC, 1860, and 326/307 of IPC added later on registered at Police Station Kathgarh, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner on the other side controverts the said fact informing the Court that the petitioner has been declared innocent by the investigating agency and faced with the situation, Mr. Rakesh Binder Singh, SI is present in Court to assist Mr. Mohit Chaudhary, AAG Punjab also corroborates the said fact informing that challan is ready and petitioner Kulwinder Singh @ Binder has been declared innocent. He

also states that challan is pending with the competent authorities for approval which will be sent to Court within a period of two weeks from today.

In the light of the statement made by the police official who is present in Court, counsel for the petitioner submits that instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

Prayer is accepted.

Since the petition has become infructuous, the same is ordered to be disposed of as having become rendered infructuous.
