The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 01.10.2020
passed in CWP-15954-2020, which reads as under: -

*“The petitioner who was initially appointed on 15.9.2014 as
Assistant Professor on contractual basis has been continuing as
such and the last extension as accorded to him was on 31.7.2019.*

*The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner now apprehends his replacement by another person
who is to be appointed on contractual basis as would be evident
from the advertisement dated 28.7.2020 (Annexure P-19).*

Notice of motion for 21.1.2021.

At this stage Mr. M.K. Dogra, Advocate, puts in appearance on behalf of the respondent and accepts notice.

Meanwhile, the petitioner be not replaced by another person appointed on contractual basis provided the work and conduct of the petitioner has been satisfactory.”

Learned counsel for the respondent, on the basis of affidavit of Vice Chancellor, Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, submits that the petitioner served the respondent-University till 31.05.2020 and in July, 2020, an advertisement was issued, in which the petitioner has also competed, but was not found suitable and two persons, who were selected, were issued appointment letters on 28.09.2020 and only thereafter, the order dated 01.10.2020 was passed.

In view of the specific stand taken by the respondent, no willful disobedience is made out.

Dismissed.
